ごみ出しのルール

Trash disposal rules
Pagtatapon ng Basura

- ▶ごみは分別し、決まった曜日・時間・場所に捨てます。
- ▶You MUST sort your trash and throw it away ONLY in a designated area at a designated time and day of the week.
- ▶Paghiwa-hiwalayin ang basura at itapon sa tamang araw, oras, at lugar.
- ▶道路や空き地などに、ごみを捨ててはいけません。
- ▶DO NOT leave trash anywhere except for specified places.
- ▶Ipinagbabawal ang magtapon sa kalsada o sa bakanteng lote.
- ▶外でごみを燃やすことは禁止です。
- ▶DO NOT burn trash outside.
- ▶Ipinagbabawal ang pagsusunog ng basura sa labas.
- ▶住んでいる市町村で、ルールが違います。市町村のホームページを見てください。
- ▶Trash disposal rules are different in every city. Please check your city's website for rules in your area.
- ▶Magkakaiba ang patakaran bawat syudad-tingnan ang homepage ng inyong city hall o municipal office.



自転車の乗り方のルール

Bicycle riding rules
Paggamit ng Bisikleta

- ▶自転車に乗るときは、道の左側を走ります。
- ▶Only ride the bicycle on the LEFT side of the road.
- ▶Magbisikleta sa kaliwang bahagi ng kalsada.
- ▶けいたい電話やイヤホンを使いながら、自転車に乗ってはいけません。
- ▶DO NOT use your phone or earphones while riding a bicycle.
- ▶Ipinagbabawal ang cellphone at earphone habang nagbibisikleta.



- ▶暗い時は、ライトをつけるといけません。
- ▶You MUST have a light on your bicycle when it's dark.
- ▶Buksan ang ilaw kapag madilim.

うるさくしない

Don't be too loud
Pag-iwas sa Ingay

- ▶アパート、マンションでは、大きい声で話したり、大きい音で音楽を聞いてはいけません。
- ▶DO NOT talk loudly or listen to loud music inside your apartment.
- ▶Sa apartment, mansion o tirahan, bawal ang malakas na ingay o musika.



- ▶家の外（公園など）でも、朝早くや夜遅くは静かにしましょう。

- ▶Stay quiet outside and in public spaces on early mornings and late evenings.
- ▶Maging tahimik sa labas (gaya ng parke), panatiliing tahimik lalo na sa maagang umaga at gabi.



- ▶夜遅くに花火をしてはいけません。
- ▶DO NOT set off fireworks late in the evening or at night.
- ▶Ipinagbabawal ang pagpapaputok o hanabi nang gabi o dis-oras ng gabi.

税金と年金を支払う

Pension and tax payments
Magbayad ng Buwisat Pensyon

- ▶外国人も、税金や年金を支払う必要があります。
- ▶Even as a foreigner, you MUST pay taxes and pension in Japan.
- ▶Obligado ang lahat, pati dayuhan, namagbayad ng buwis at pensyon.



- ▶国民健康保険も税金の1つです。
- ▶National Health Insurance is also a form of tax.
- ▶Ang National Health Insurance (kokumin kenkou Hoken) ay isa sa mga binabayarang buwis.

- ▶国民年金は、国籍を問わず、日本に住む20~59歳の方は支払う義務があります。

- ▶If you are 20~59 years old, you MUST enroll into National Pension System.

- ▶Lahat ng edad 20-59 na nakatira sa Japan ay dapat magbayad ng National Pension (Kokumin Nenkin).
